The rights to vote, to elect and to be elected are the foundations of a democratic society.

These rights allow citizens to participate in the expression of popular will and to safeguard government activity.

At the communal level, the Constitution of the canton of Vaud allows people of foreign nationality to vote, elect and be elected, under certain conditions.

In Gland, these rights are guaranteed if you :

- are at least 18 years old.
- are domiciled in Gland, with a B or C permit.
- have been domiciled in the canton of Vaud for the last three years without interruption (with a B, C, Ci, N or F permit).
- have had residence in Switzerland for the last ten years without interruption (with a B, B student, C, Ci, N, F or L permit).

NB: these conditions are cumulative

The PLR Gland strongly encourages you to make use of your constitutional rights and to participate in the next communal votes or elections. This will allow you to better understand the functioning of our commune, to take an active part in the issues that concern you directly and to add your input as a foreigner.
